### Prestigious Pedigree

Ball Of Fire's sire is EP Cambridge Risk Taker ET who has had a tremendous impact across the herd producing 'next level' cria. These have recently included the winning white and dark fawn junior males at the 2017 Australian Alpaca Spectacular.

This is no surprise given that Risk Taker's mother, EP Cambridge Illustrious, is herself a national champion and hails from the most elite 'Royal' lines at EP Cambridge.

Risk Taker has an extremely advanced, high frequency crimp style and exceptional substance of bone. This advanced style runs from head to toe with an amazing fineness. He is passing all these traits to his cria along with his super placid nature.

Ball Of Fire's mother, EP Cambridge Lady Ursula, is a superfine solid light fawn Caesar daughter. He was her first cria and she did not disappoint. She has since produced a half brother and full sister to Ball Of Fire...both of excellent quality. She is a very fertile and consistent female who will be a donor in our next embryo transfer program. She is a classic Caesar/Spartacus cross and is passing on her fine and bright fleece characteristics.

### Powerhouse of Genetics

It is hard to find a pedigree that contains more of Australia's most recognised and revered stud males. These super sires have all played a part in producing the next generation of elite stud males like Ball Of Fire.



**COMMISARIO** - stunning presence, density and brightness...this male has consistently thrown all of these traits in his offspring producing countless champions.



**RUFFO** - a name we can rely on for fineness. His daughters play a key role in the breeding herd and are very rarely released. The genetics behind many of our elite lines.



SPARTACUS - must have genetics throughout Australia and Europe. Sire of National Champions, this male has left one of the most potent genetic lines at EP Cambridge.



**CONQUISTADOR** - a supreme champion and producer of supreme champions, 'Con' is one of the greats and sired some of the most iconic stud males in Australia.



CAESAR - selected in Peru in 2000 he was only ever used in-house at EP Cambridge. This male had the most advanced fleece Matthew and Cathy have seen and is a key part of many elite lines. The characteristics of Caesar's advanced fleece style can be seen coming through in Ball Of Fire.

### Fleece Statistics

EP Cambridge Ball Of Fire has a beautiful fleece not only to look at and handle but the statistics are fantastic. His shearing sample in 2016 came in at only 15.4 micron and an SD of only 3.1. This is evident when you open his fleece and see just how consistent it is across his blanket, into his chest and up his neck.

This is an Ultrafine male who is sure to maintain his fineness as he ages as in his genes. At 4.5 years old, his mother (3635Y) is still Superfine at only 18.9 micron with an SD of 4.1.

This fineness and consistency along with a bright, dense fleece and advanced crimp style make Ball Of Fire a very complete stud with the traits to produce beautiful cria.
